Adams Electric Credentials & Election Committee

The **Credentials & Election Committee** is made up of 12 randomly selected member volunteers representing all nine zones. One member from each director zone is selected for the committee by the board at their December meeting. A second committee member is also selected for the three zones where the board member is up for election that year.

The Election Committee supervises the process for electing directors. This includes acting as a nominating committee in the event that no petition is received from a zone where a director is to be elected.

Committee members fulfill their responsibilities during the following meetings:

- Early February, an organizational meeting is held to validate the candidate petitions.
- Mid-February for a candidate meeting if applicable.
- March at the member meetings, a committee member gives an Election Committee report in their zone. If there is a contested election, the two committee members from that zone collect ballots cast at the meeting. The primary election determines the order of the names in that zone on the general election ballot
- End of March to certify the primary election results.
- Friday, the day before the annual meeting, committee members certify mail-in ballots for the general election.
- Saturday, at the annual meeting, committee members tally the ballots cast in person and announce the winners of the election.

For each meeting attended, the members of the Election Committee receive a small stipend and are reimbursed for mileage.

Adams Electric Member Advisory Committee

The **Member Advisory Committee (MAC)** is made up of 27 member volunteers (three from each director zone) and their spouses who meet at least twice a year. This committee acts in an advisory capacity to the board and management staff. A term is two calendar years, with a maximum of three consecutive terms (total of six years).

MAC usually meets in the spring and fall. Special trips and special meetings can be called by the co-op. All meetings are planned and coordinated by the Communications/Community Service Department. The content of the meeting can be based on important issues or information that the members should know, the need to test a member or co-op related idea with a representative group of members, new technology, change in rates or policies, or based upon a request from the committee itself.

Members of the MAC Committee are reimbursed each calendar year for mileage to meetings attended.

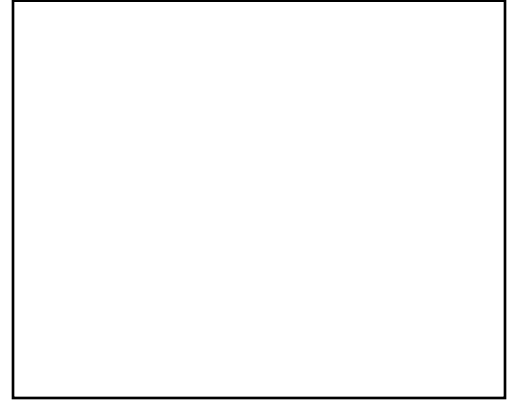

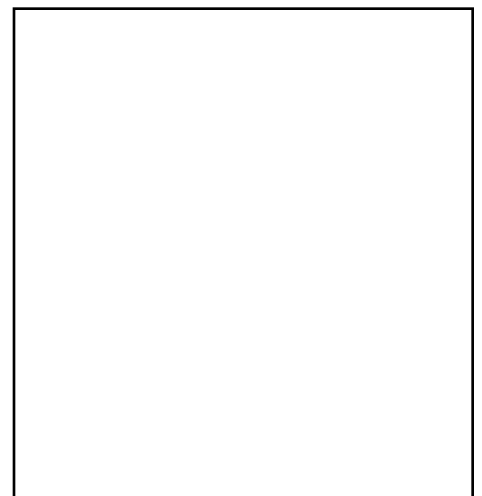

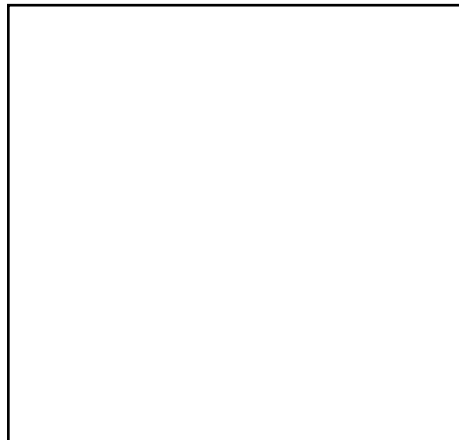

Adams Electric Scholarship Committee

The **Scholarship Committee** is made up of nine Adams Electric members. This committee selects winners of the Adams Electric Cooperative Scholarship from applicants not attending one of 17 public high schools that award a co-op scholarship. The committee also selects winners of the co-op's adult scholarship. The committee meets at least twice in the spring and once in the summer to determine scholarship winners. A term is three years.

Committee members fulfill their responsibilities by:

- Attending an organizational meeting.
- Attending meetings to select scholarship winners.

Members of the scholarship committee are reimbursed each calendar year for mileage to meetings attended.
