Contributions to ACRE Co-op Owners for Political Action® are not tax deductible. All contributions to ACRE are voluntary and will be used for political purposes. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal. Contribution guidelines are suggestions only. You may contribute more or less than the recommended amount. Contributions may be stopped at any time upon notification to the cooperative.

What is ACRE®?

ACRE® is the non-partisan political action committee of the nation's electric cooperatives founded in 1966 by members of the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA). ACRE supports candidates for state and federal office who will speak for and protect the interests of electric co-ops and their members. It is funded with contributions from co-op employees and directors. Similarly, Co-op Owners is funded with contributions from members. ACRE provides a voice for electric cooperatives on all levels of government.

A political action committee (PAC) is a group of people with common goals who contribute to candidates who share their interests and views.

Contributions


With the exception of a small federal tax payment of less than 1 percent, all contributions to ACRE Co-op Owners go directly to the campaigns of candidates for political office. About half of all contributions go to support candidates for state office, the other half for federal office.

ACRE follows established procedures for making contributions to candidates running for political office. Factors that determine financial support include a candidate's:

- Position on issues critical to electric co-ops, as well as their votes and public statements on these issues;
- Committee assignments and leadership positions and his or her relative importance to co-ops; and
- Financial need and the strength of an opponent. The candidate's political affiliation is never taken into account.
