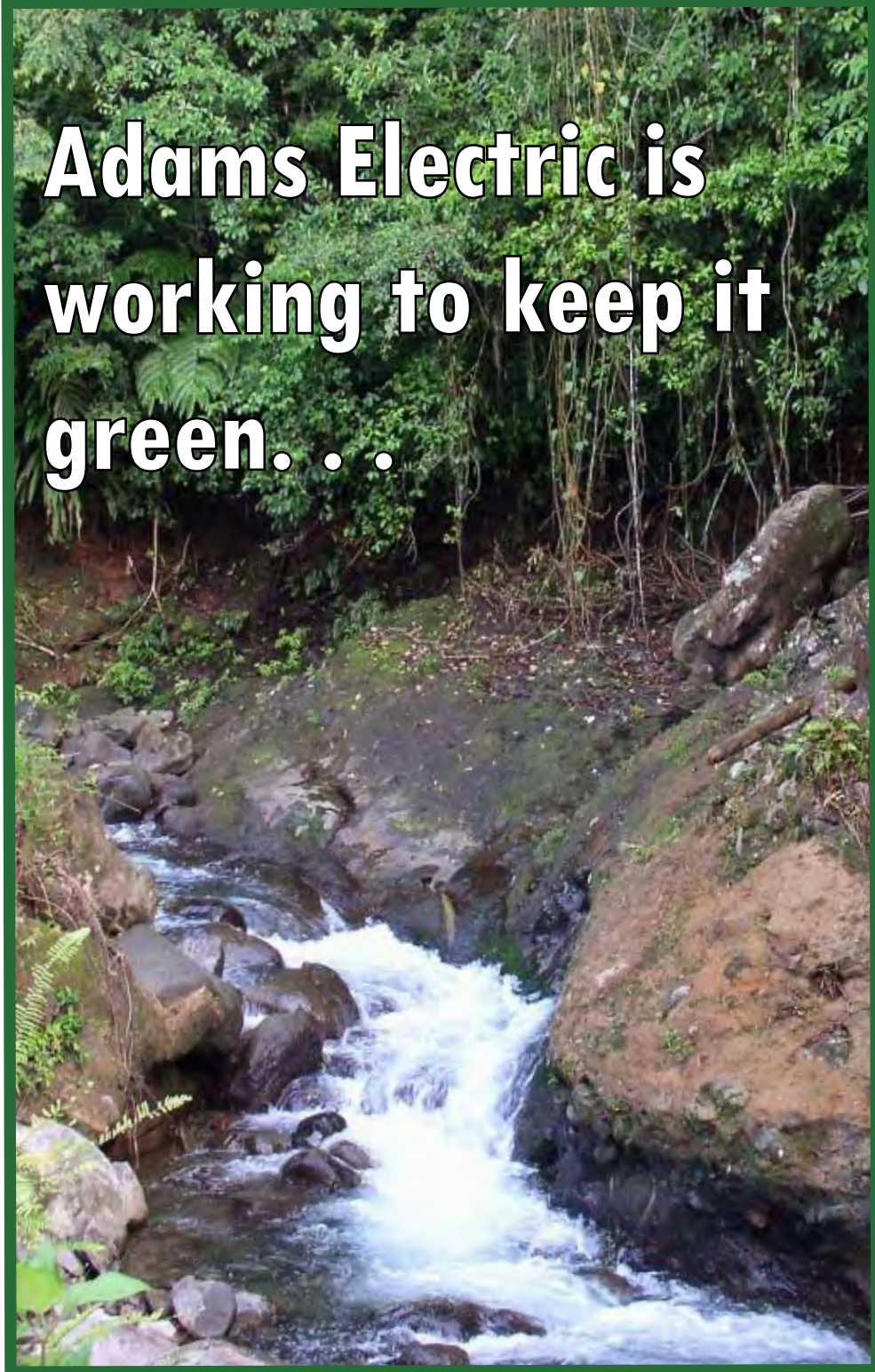

## Load Management

The co-op offers its members a peak-reduction device to briefly switch off the electrical current to water heaters, electric thermal storage units and air conditioner compressors in the winter and summer months. This is only used during a peak demand for electricity to save energy. Peak demand periods occur when everyone on the electric grid is trying to heat or cool their homes at the same time.
