

# Adams Electric Cooperative Scholarships

## High school seniors in public schools

Scholarships are offered to a deserving senior attending each of the 17 public high schools in the co-op's service area.

### How to apply

See your guidance counselor for an application. The \$500 scholarships are made available through each school's scholarship application process. A committee from each school chooses the winner.



### Participating public schools:

ADAMS COUNTY: Bermudian Springs High School, Biglerville High School, Fairfield Area High School, Gettysburg Area High School, Littlestown Senior High School and New Oxford High School

CUMBERLAND COUNTY: Big Spring High School

FRANKLIN COUNTY: Chambersburg Area Senior High School and Shippensburg Area Senior High School

YORK COUNTY: Dallastown Area High School, Dover Area Senior High School, Kennard-Dale High School, Northern York High School, Red Lion Area Senior High School, South Western High School, Spring Grove Area Senior High School and Susquehannock High School

## High school seniors in other schools

Seniors attending other schools (ex: vocational/technical, cyber, private, home school or other public schools) are also eligible to apply for a \$500 scholarship.

### How to apply

Go to the co-op's Web site, [www.adamsec.coop](http://www.adamsec.coop) and click on "Scholarships" under "Student Corner." Applications are also available at the co-op's offices in Shippensburg, Gettysburg and York.

### To qualify for a high school scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a high school senior;
- Receive electricity from Adams Electric at their primary residence;
- Be accepted in a post-secondary program at an accredited institution (two-year, four-year or technical);
- Maintain a cumulative high school grade-point average of 2.5 or above;
- Show a commitment to community; and
- Show a financial need.

## Adults who want to move ahead

Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each are available to Adams Electric Cooperative members (not their children) going back to school.

### How to apply

Go to the co-op's Web site, [www.adamsec.coop](http://www.adamsec.coop) and click on "Scholarships" under "Student Corner." Applications are also available at the co-op's offices in Shippensburg, Gettysburg and York.

### To qualify for an adult scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a member of Adams Electric in good standing, for at least one year, with their name on the bill;
- Be accepted at a post-secondary program or accredited training program; and
- Not be an Adams Electric employee, director or Scholarship Committee member.

The Adams Electric Cooperative Scholarships are funded by unclaimed patronage capital money. They are in no way related to rates.

## Statewide Scholarships

The Pennsylvania Rural Electric Association's Scholarship Trust Fund in Memory of William F. Matson offers the following:

**At least five \$1,000 scholarships** are available to sons and daughters of members and employees of electric cooperatives in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. Applicants must currently be high school seniors.

**At least two \$1,000 scholarships** in memory of Jody Loudenslager are available to college-bound or current college students who participated in the National Rural Electric Youth Tour, coordinated by Pennsylvania Rural Electric Association (PREA).
