TIPS TO AVOID SCAMS

Beware of con artists with unrealistic promises of how you can save on your energy bill.

1. Remember there is no such thing as free energy.
2. Be wary of “now-or-never” or “limited time” offers.
3. Do your homework before you replace heating and cooling equipment.
4. Be sure you understand what you are purchasing.
5. Do not give out personal financial information over the phone or web unless you know who you are giving it to.
6. Treat reloadable debit cards like cash. Never send one, or give out the activation/pin number from one, to someone you do not know.

You can never be too careful of whom you let on your property, let alone in your home.
